Summary

The project team staffed a booth at the Mat-Su Transportation Fair and talked to many people about the project. The event hosted over 100 different transportation related projects and programs from several different agencies, including the Department of Transportation and Public Facilities (DOT&PF), the Mat-Su Borough, and the Alaska Railroad.

Comments

The team summarized the following questions, answers, and comments about the project.

- Will there be signs on Beverly Lake Road for Seldon?

Team response: We will coordinate with the Mat-Su Borough for the addition of signs outside of the project limits.

- A commenter stated a preference for a roundabout at the Seldon/Pittman intersection.
- A property owner asked about access to Seldon from his property across from the proposed Beverly Lane.

Team response: The Mat-Su Borough Corridor Access Management Plan will allow access to be constructed to the north, across from Beverly Lane.

- Will there be stop signs for the roadway approaches to Seldon Road?

Team response: Yes, the approach roads will need to stop prior to entering Seldon Road.

- When will construction start?

Team response: The current schedule shows construction starting in 2027.

- How high is Seldon Road above Beverly Lake Road?

Team response: Seldon Road will be between 5-10 feet above Beverly Lake Road in the vicinity of Beverly Drive.

- The team had a discussion with a property owner located where a new culvert crosses under Beverly Lake Road. We clarified what he can expect by showing details in the plans.
- The project team received an overall positive response from those individuals who visited the booth.
